Award of the Bronze Star Medal - Citation

Second Lieutenant <then Corporal> Alwyn D. Conger, 0887446, 113th Field Artillery Battalion, United States Army, is awarded the Bronze Star for meritorious conduct on 18 August 1944, in France. While Lieutenant Conger was serving as a forward observer with an artillery battalion, it was learned that two officers had been injured when their vehicle struck a mine about a mile and a half out beyond the outpost. He alone set out to find the injured men and render whatever aid was necessary. Despite the dangers of enemy patrols and enemy fire, he went to the injured comrades, placed them on a medical vehicle, and removed them to the rear. The outstanding courage and loyalty to the wounded comrades displayed by Lt. Conger reflect high credit on himself and the Armed Forces. Entered military service from California.
